Keynote Lecture:

"More Than Just a Pretty Beach - Marine Shorelines as Critical Habitats"

Guest speaker, Ramona de Graaf, BSc. MSc., Research Coordinator and Consultant, is a marine biologist, forage fish specialist, marine educator and researcher. Ramona has studied marine systems from the deep sea to eelgrass, marine population genetics, cetaceans and plankton. As the principal of Emerald Sea Biological she launched the BC Shore Spawners Alliance which currently has 27 communities involved in volunteer forage fish survey efforts at 32 beaches. These surveys have been used to help communities write bylaws for beach protection.
